Customer information regarding changes as a result of the Brexit

In the course of the running countdown to the Brexit CTC advanced feels committed to inform about the upcoming changes due to this situation within the EU.

One core adventure lies in a solution for the future cooperation within the European market, to maintain the standard in environmental and health and the valid regulations.

It is essential to prevent distortions or impediments from the European single market.

With the objective to analyse the risks, fix them and find solutions, the BDI has triggered a task force. Their intention is the coordination of this recent subject for the German economy as a whole. Parts of this task force are – among others – the DIHK, the Bundesvereinigung für Arbeitgeberverbände (BDA), the Bundesverband Deutscher Banken (BDB) and other associations.

What does a hart Brexit mean to you as manufacturer? The current regulations address the exchange of goods between the United Kingdom and Europe. Even in a softer Brexit scenario SERVICES are currently excluded in the discussions. Notified Body services fall into the group of these services. A hard Brexit means that any UK-based Notified Body loses its European NB status by March, 30th 2019. Furthermore, all companies having their European representative offices in UK and willing to launch products on the European market, need to search for a new representative within the EU-27.

But that's not all. Even companies, which already have TECs, coming from Notified Bodies of the UK, are forced to apply for new TECs in the EU-27.
