

Information Type Approval Australia / New Zealand

Customer Information regarding SDoC in Australia (AS) / New Zealand (NZ)

We, CTC advanced GmbH, would like to inform you about the Type Approval process in **Australia/New Zealand**.

Australia and New Zealand do not have a Type Approval scheme for radio equipment. Local companies which would like to sell radio devices need to sign a SDoC and register at ERAC.

Australia and New Zealand have own radio and EMC requirements, but most of the European and some of the FCC specifications are accepted to declare the conformity towards the Australian regulations.

A national label must be affixed to the device and/or printed in the user manual and the packaging.

Devices built-in, in FCAI-member vehicles are exempted from the labelling notice.

Please note:

Different states within Australia and New Zealand do have their own safety regulations. Safety relevant devices need to be registered in ERAC database.

There is an MRA between Australia and New Zealand, so most SRDs can be sold within Australia and New Zealand with just one SDoC.
