

# Information TRCSL Sri Lanka Type Approval

## Customer information regarding TRCSL Sri Lanka Type Approval

We, CTC advanced GmbH, would like to inform you about some major changes in the Type Approval process in Sri Lanka. The Telecommunications Regulatory Commission of Sri Lanka (TRCSL) amended the Sri Lanka Telecommunications Act No: 25 of 1991 for Radio and Telecommunications Terminal Equipment (RTTE). These Certification/Type Approval rules published in the Extra Ordinary Gazette No. 2196/51 of 09.10.2020, are effective from December 16, 2020.

### Major changes:

- Current type approvals will automatically be cancelled upon the expiry of six months with deadline of 2021-06-16. Therefore, if you intend to place your devices on the market in Sri Lanka you need to reapprove your devices under the new scheme for RTTEs
- Standard lead time is up to 30 working days
- A representative sample (as sold) shall be submitted, but TRCSL could request a second one and keeps them both for a period of up to two years for market surveillance reasons
- There are three schemes of compliance: Simplified Type Approval, Standard Type Approval & Exception Letter. All these categories depend on the Commission's type approval register

### Requirements for Simplified Type Approval:

TCF with design, manufacturer and operation mode, including:

1. Declaration of Conformity (DoC)
2. Circuit diagrams and Printed Circuit Board (PCB) layouts
3. Photographs of both the interior assembly and exterior
4. Details of the encryption types from the manufacturer, if the equipment supports encryption systems
5. Test reports are not required
6. 1 x representative sample

Requirements for Standard Type Approval:

TCF with design, manufacturer and operation mode, including:

1. Declaration of Conformity (DoC)
2. Circuit diagrams and Printed Circuit Board (PCB) layouts
3. Photographs of both the interior assembly and exterior
4. Details of the encryption types from the manufacturer, if the equipment supports encryption systems
5. Test reports issued by accredited testing laboratories - the date of the test report shall not be older than three 3 months
6. No-Change-Declaration if your device was not tested within the last 3 months
7. 1 x representative sample

Requirements for Exception Letter:

1. Data sheet
2. DoC
3. User manual
4. Lab test reports (EMC, RF, Safety & Health)
5. Other relevant documents (layout, photos, etc...)
6. No sample

The validity of Exception Letter is 4 years.
